Horseshoes

Event Coordinator

Venue: Mojave Narrows Regional Park – Pelican Lake

PARTICIPANTS:

Competition will consist of (1) Co-ed team (1 male/1 female). A maximum of (2) person roster and (1) alternate. Alternate must play entire match.

Employees must be from their respective company only.

National Horseshoe Pitcher's Association of America rules apply with some modification to ensure an effective event. See Event Leader for specific changes.

RULES:

1. Teams must report to the site a minimum of 15 minutes before their scheduled check in time.
2. Participate must wear shoes at all times during the event.
3. No smoking or drinking in the pits.
4. Only alternates on the roster will be allowed to substitute once the tournament play has started and may be used for injury or “no show” only.
5. The tournament is a double elimination tournament.
6. The choice of the first pitch is determined by the toss of a coin. The winner of the toss gets the choice.
7. Each person throws two horseshoes during each of the respective turns.
 - Each team gets a total of 32 throws.
8. Horseshoes must be within 6” of stake to score
9. Points counting:
 - a) A ringer counts 3 points.
 - b) A leaner counts 1 point.
 - c) There is **no point** and the **shoe must be pulled** if:
 - A shoe hits before the 40’ foul line.
 - A shoe hits the front board first.
 - A shoe hits the backboard.
 - A shoe hits the concrete.
 - A shoe hits object outside the box at any time during throw.
10. Winner of points throws first.
11. The team ahead at the time wins.
12. Tie Breaker: If a tie exists at this point, each team member throws two additional shoes in rotating order until the tie is broken (down & back).

AWARDS:

Medals will be awarded to the first, second and third place winners.

FORFEITS:

- A forfeit will be declared if a team arrives more than 10 minutes after the event start time without notification.

TIE-BREAKER

- In the event of a tie for first place, the company with the highest finishing Coed pair will be declared the winner.
