Table Tennis

Venue: West Winds / SCLA

PARTICIPANTS:

Competition will consist of (1) Team with two players (Male or Female).
Employees of their respective company only.

- **Teams must provide their own equipment.**

Game: Table tennis games are self-refereed. Each player must have knowledge of all the rules and is responsible for making calls against the opposing player.

Monitors: Table monitors will be provided, when possible, and will be responsible only for recording the scores as reported by the players and submitting the final results to the event statistician.

Equipment: Tables are provided. Players must provide their own racquet and balls.

- The racquet must be made of wood and may be covered by rubber or foam.
- Sandpaper racquets are not allowed
- We will be using ITTF Standard Balls, 40 millimeters in diameter and 2.7 grams in weight (orange or white in color)

Play: Format of play to be announced!!

1. Teams must report to the site a minimum of 15 minutes before their scheduled check in time.
2. Games are to 11 points; must win by 2 points.
3. Players alternate serves every two (2) points until deuce (10-all)
4. Matches are best of five
5. A game shall be won by the team first scoring 11 points unless the teams score 10 points, when the game shall be won by the first team subsequently gaining a lead of 2 points.
6. The order of serving, receiving and ends.
 - a) After each 2 points have been scored, the receiving team shall become the serving team and serve until the end of the game unless the team scores 10 points, when the sequence of serving and receiving shall be the same, but each team shall serve for only 1 point in turn.
 - b) The team serving first in the game shall receive first in the next game of the match, and in the last possible game of a double match, the team due to receive next shall change their order of receiving when the first team scores 5 points.
The team starting at one end in a game shall start at the other end in the next game of the match and in the last possible game of the match, the team shall change ends when first team scores 5 points.

Intentional Delay of Game: *20-second Rule: After the completion of a point, the next serve must be made within 20 seconds.*

The following penalties are imposed for intentional delay of game:

- 1st offense constitutes a verbal warning
- 2nd offense results in a loss of point
- 3rd offense results in loss of game
- 4th offense is a loss of match

AWARDS:

Medals will be awarded to the first, second and third place winners.

FORFEITS:

- A forfeit will be declared if a team arrives more than 10 minutes after the event start time without notification.
- Rules are determined by event coordinators day of play.
